All participating horses must be AMHR registered. All horses must be measured before an exhibitor number is issued. Valid AMHR registration, coggins dated within 12 months for out-of-state horses (NY horses can have 2010/2011 coggins), rabies certificate within 1 year, health certificate within 30 days for out-of-state horses, youth and/or amateur numbers must be provided. **Make checks payable to: Tri-State Miniature Horse Society. General Rules and Information:

This show is accredited and conducted under the 2011 rules and regulations of the American Miniature Horse Registry. All horses must be registered with the American Miniature Horse Registry. This show is double judged. Points and awards will be awarded by each judge. Ribbons will be awarded for 1st – 6th places. Championship Ribbons will be awarded to Champions, Reserves, Grand Champions & Reserves. Champion of Champion class will receive Awards but is a non rated class.

General Rules and Information:

Stabling: Over 300 10' x 10' box stalls with paved floors. Use of straw as bedding is prohibited. Shavings available for \$7.00 per bag. **Shavings must be pre-ordered with your entries.** Stalls are \$40.00 for one night or \$50.00 for the weekend. No more than two horses per stall. **If you wish to show off your trailer, there is a fee of \$15.00 per horse.** If you wish to be stabled with another exhibitor/farm, please indicate this on your entry form.

Wash Rack: Paved wash rack area is located at the far end of the pole barn (next to the food stand).

Arena: Large indoor arena; outdoor warm-up ring available.

Camping: Camper hookups and a picnic pavilion available. Camper permits are \$25.00 per night and are required whether you are sleeping in a van, tent, stall or camper. Anyone using two plugs will be charged for two hookups. Bathrooms with showers are available for both men and women.

Parking: All exhibitors showing from trailers must park on the field behind the fire tower. No trailers are allowed to park in the roadways or near the arenas.

Smoking: No smoking will be allowed in the barns, the arena or in the horse show office.

Local Directions: Chemung County Fairgrounds is on Grand Ave in Horseheads, NY. From Rte. 17 in Horseheads, take Grand Central Ave South about one mile, Fairgrounds will be on the left.

From the Interstate 90: Take Rte. 81 South to Rte. 281, Exit 12 to Rte. 13, South to Rte. 17 East

From Pennsylvania: Rte. 14 North or Rte. 81 North to Rte. 17 West

From the Rochester: Rte. 390 South to Rte. 81 North

From Buffalo/Niagara Falls: Rte. 20 East to Rte. 390 South to Rte. 17 East

Measuring: Measuring will take place on Thursday from 6:00 PM to 8:00 PM and Friday Morning from 7:00 AM to 8:00 AM. and at Lunch Break. All horses must be measured prior to exhibitor packets and numbers issued. A clear copy of your registration papers must be presented at measuring.

Office Please have a copy of your horse's coggins current within 12 months, rabies and a 30-day health certificate on all out-of-state horses. New York horses must have a coggins dated 2010 or 2011 and a rabies certificate within one year. If a horse is gelded, "gelding" must be indicated on the registration papers in order to show.

Entries: All entry forms, copies of both sides of the AMHR registration papers for each horse, copy of Coggins papers, copy 2011 Amateur and/or Youth cards and a check/money order in payment of classes, stalls, RV fees, etc., are

to be sent to Show Manager Lea Dill. Checks are to be made payable to Tri-State Miniature Horse Society (TSMHS). Entries postmarked after the pre-entry deadline of June 1st, 2011 will be assessed a post-entry fee of \$10.00 per horse. This fee will be strictly enforced. Any checks not honored by the bank will be charged a \$35.00 NSF fee. All monies must be paid or an open check left at the office before numbers will be issued.

- Refunds:** Refunds will only be given on receipt of a veterinary certificate stating the reason the horse may not be shown. Stall fees and office fees will not be refunded. No refunds will be issued at the show. TSMHS will be notified and a refund will be mailed to you.
- PA System:** It is the owner/handler/exhibitor's responsibility to be on time for classes. Announcements to the barn area is a management courtesy. We will be using a two-minute gate call. Please check in with the gate person when you arrive at the gate.
- Pets:** All dogs must be leashed and proof of current rabies vaccinations.
- Conduct:** Cruelty, abuse or inhumane treatment of any horse in the show ring, barn, stalls or on the fairgrounds is strictly prohibited. The use of stimulants or depressants or any drug affecting the showing of a horse is forbidden. Anyone guilty of the above will have their entries cancelled and will be ordered off the grounds immediately. No refunds will be given.
- Youth Classes:** All youth must have an AMHR Youth number to participate. Application for a Youth card may be filled out day of show at the Horse Show Office. **AMHR youth are those youth 18 years & under as of December 31, 2010.**
- Amateur** An AMHR Amateur Card is required to participate in Amateur classes. Applications are available with the show Steward.
- PMC Needs:** Exhibitors with special needs are welcome to participate in the show. If special accommodations are needed, please let the show manager know in advance.
- Newcomer Classes:** Newcomer classes (Youth and Adult) are open to anyone who has not shown at a miniature horse show. Horses can be borrowed by the newcomer and classes are open to mares and geldings only. The newcomer can have a mentor in the ring with them if needed. Show clothes are not necessary, but the exhibitor must have closed toe shoes. Ribbons will be awarded for first through sixth place.
- Novice Classes:** At all of our TSMHS shows we will be offering a full complement of Novice classes, both Halter and Performance, for youth and adults. Novice classes are designed for those adults and youth who are either new to showing their minis, or just do not feel seasoned enough to compete at higher levels. The Judges are allowed to speak to the exhibitors. Novices are encouraged to participate in other Youth and Amateur classes as eligible and any Open Halter or Performance classes that the horses are eligible.
- TSMHC:** The Tri-State Miniature Horse Society was accepted as an official AMHA club at the Annual Meeting in February 2010. The purpose of the club is to promote and improve the Amateur and Youth Exhibitor within the AMHA in both Halter and Performance by offering a complete schedule of Amateur Classes, Youth Classes, and in addition, all Open Performance Classes. The goal of TSMHS is to increase participation of both Amateur and Youth exhibitors by holding shows that are both affordable and enjoyable. In an effort to increase participation of new owners and inexperienced exhibitors, non-rated Newcomer and Novice classes will be offered specifically for them at every show.
